# OUR COURT

## Import vs local

Having considered factors such as technical skills, material consistency in delivery, etc. we decided to opt for imported court components. These components are manufactured in a dedicated factory that has delivered court components across the globe.

### Points to ponder

Having inspected some courts already constructed in SA we have noticed a few variables that should be considered when constructing Padel Courts.

#### Concrete slab

We have observed different quality concrete slabs used for court construction. Some courts displayed drainage issues due to incorrect sloping and others used thin screed layers to level the surface which crumbles and causes surface damage.

We have decided to opt for a 30MPA strength concrete for our bases with two different options for the steel reinforcing

#### Steel

We have noticed a number of courts constructed with thinner steel which will have a price impact but could also have a quality impact. Our steel components are 3mm throughout to ensure maximum strength

#### Turf

Artificial turf quality can vary from site to site. We use a turf with a 525000 needles per m<sup>2</sup>



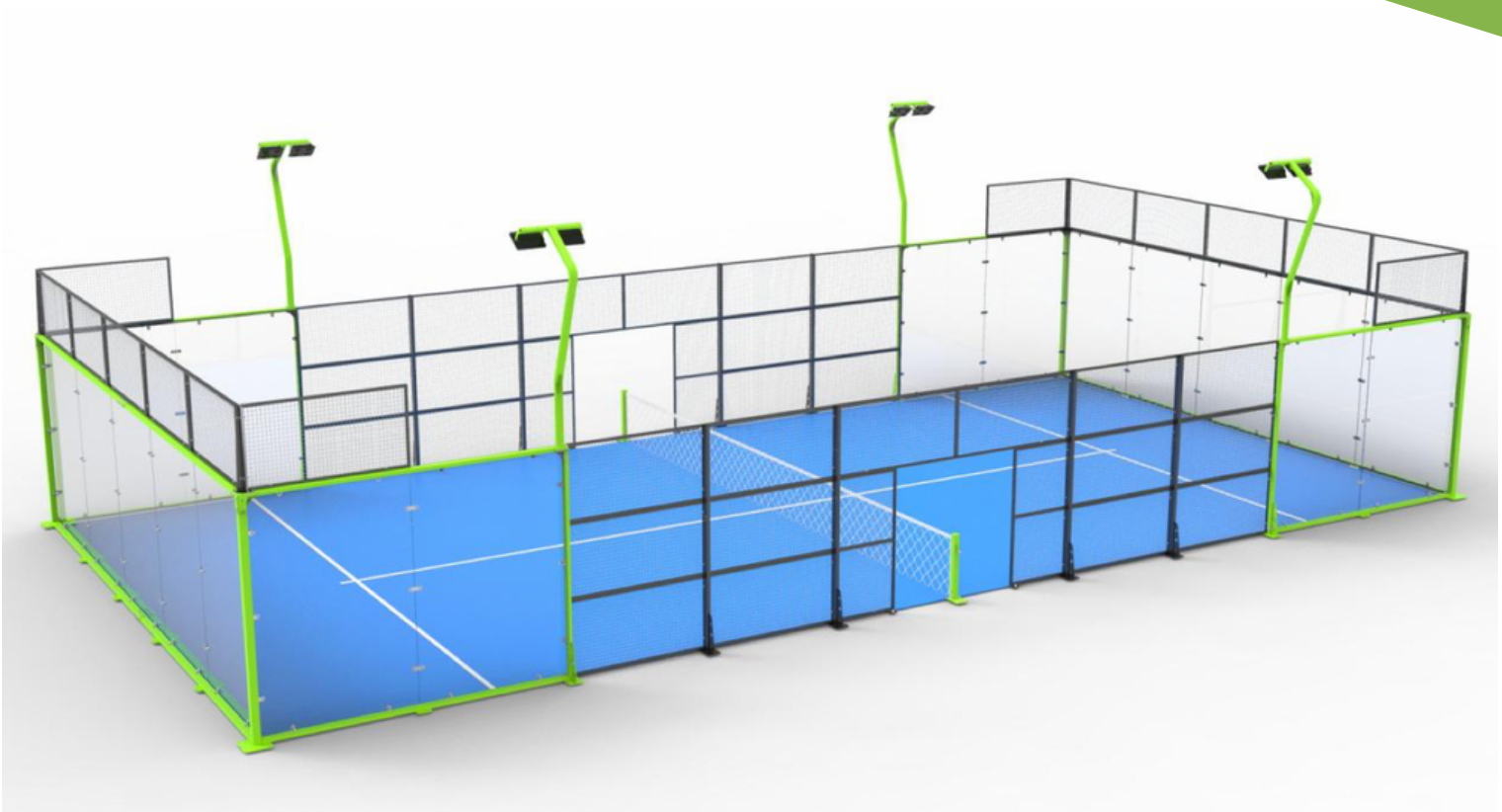

## Space Requirement

A Padel Court is 20m x 10m in size.  
A club consisting of 4 courts and a small clubhouse requires roughly 35m x 35m.

**Estimated Cost for 4 courts    R 2 300 000.00**

**Concrete base** **R 100 000.00**

30 MPA Concrete base with Ref 100 steel reinforcement  
22 x 12m with a brick border. 15cm thick slab on compacted soil and aggregate subbase. Final cost subject to soil drainage assessment

**Panoramic Padel Court** **R 315 000.00**

12mm Tempered Glass panels  
Powder coated metal frame, mesh and light posts  
Artificial turf  
LED Lights  
Net Pole & Net  
Line  
Bolts, washers, rubbers  
Installation
